Councilor O'Leary moved, seconded by Farley, to table approval of Ordinance #1992. Council approved the motion; voice vote, unanimous.

Ordinance #1993, Amending Section 2-83 of the Sheridan City Code Pertaining to Appointment and Terms of Members of the Sheridan Travel and Tourism Commission, was read by title for the third and final reading. Councilor Farley moved, seconded by O'Leary, approval and adoption of Ordinance #1993. Councilor Farley moved, seconded by O'Leary, to amend Ordinance #1993 to return to the original reading.
