The Special Meeting was called for a decision on the County's offer for County-wide ambulance services and fire protection services to the Sheridan Area Rural Fire Protection District.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Mayor Kinskey.

The meeting was called to order with a quorum as follows: Mayor Kinskey presiding and Councilors Farley, Hansen, Severs and Webster. Councilor Ketcham was absent to abstain from discussion and vote and Councilor O'Leary was absent.

The Boards of the County Commissioners and Sheridan Area Rural Fire Protection District offered \$200,000.00 annually for County-wide ambulance services and \$150,000.00 annually for fire protection services to the Sheridan Area Rural Fire Protection District.

Councilor Webster moved, seconded by Hansen, to accept the County's and Sheridan Area Fire Protection District's offer. Council opposed the motion; voice vote, unanimous.

There being no further business, the Council adjourned at 4:59 P.M.
