November 2, 2007 Update from EnTech, Linden Project Engineers

- Hot Iron has completed all water and sanitary sewer installations along Linden, except for service line installations within the proposed cul-de-sac on the very south side. Storm sewer should be completed by Saturday, November 3rd.
- Subgrade preparation for Linden Avenue and the boulevard sidewalks has started and is continuing. Completion of the subgrade will allow for placement of gravel on Linden, which should make access to landowner properties much easier. The gravel will be overlaid with the finish asphalt.
- Hot Iron’s secondary crews have prepared for concrete sidewalk and handicapped ramp installation along Burkitt, Sherman, Griffith and Jefferson. This work should be accomplished within the next few days. These secondary crews are also backfilling areas with topsoil with the thought that sod may still be placed yet this fall.
- Construction crews continue to work Saturdays throughout this fall to attempt to complete all work.
- The Child Development Center parking lot can continue to be used as an access route for Linden residents south of the CDC’s parking lot. Their parking lot can also be used to park vehicles after 4 PM and before 8 AM on weekdays, and all day on weekends. Continued thanks to those folks for allowing this access during this construction time, and for those who have to endure the construction inconvenience.
