May 18, 2007 Update from EnTech, Linden Project Engineers....

- Demolition of asphalt pavement and concrete along Griffith Street and Burkitt Street from Griffith to Sherman was completed this week.
- Water main installation will begin on Griffith next week.
- Trees will continue to be removed in the project area. New trees will be planted in the spring of 2008.
