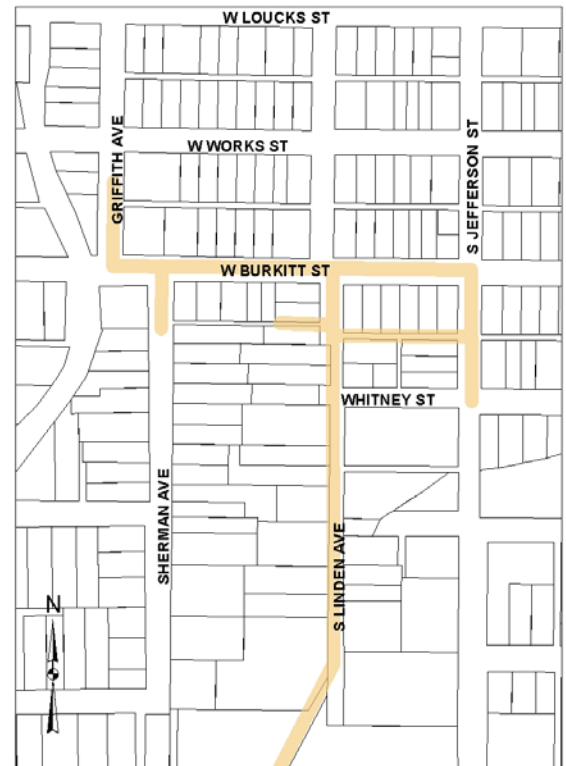

June 22, 2007, Update from EnTech, Linden Project Engineers....

- Water main installation is continuing east along Burkitt from Griffith, having passed Sherman.
- Storm sewer installation has begun along Burkitt from the intersection with Griffith. The storm sewer will be installed easterly along Burkitt, eventually to Jefferson. Holes are being cut in the retaining wall adjacent to Big Goose Creek to allow for penetration of the two storm sewer outfalls at this location.
- Construction conditions continue to improve with drier weather and Big Goose Creek water levels dropping.
- Traffic is continuing to be restricted at times at the Burkitt-Sherman intersection. Please slow down and use caution while driving through these restricted areas.



Please be cautious as construction activity increases and traffic control varies as the project progresses. This includes keeping children away from construction activity or open trenches at all times.
