Update from the City of Sheridan for the week of April 5.

- Work continues on the North Main Street project. The contractor plans to work in the following areas this next week.

### 16th Street to Goose Creek

- - The contractor continues work on the storm drain outfall from 16th Street to Goose Creek.
- - The intersection at 16th Street and Frackelton has been re-opened.

### 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Frackelton to Main Street

- - The contractor is doing utility work on 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Frackelton to Main Street.
- - 16<sup>th</sup> Street is closed from Frackelton to Main Street.

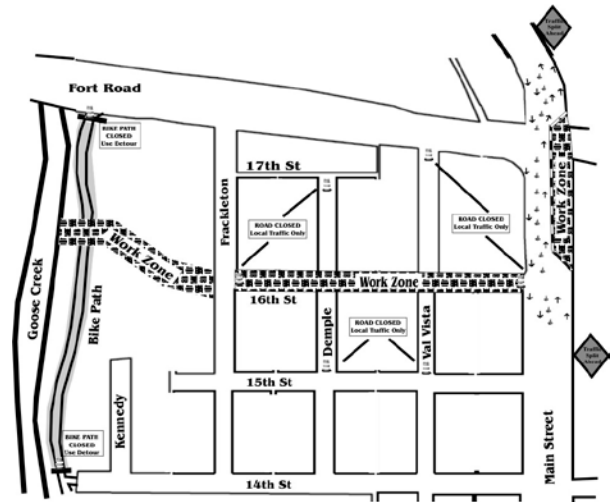
### Val Vista from Fort Road to 16th Street

- - The contractor has finished utilities on Val Vista
- - Val Vista has been re-opened to local traffic only from Fort Road to 16th Street.

### Main Street from Fort Road to 16th Street

- - The contractor continues reconstruction on the east half of Main Street from Fort Road to 16th Street.
- - Traffic continues to be shifted west to one lane in each direction.
