Message from the City of Sheridan, June 14, 2010:

Work continues on the North Main Street project. The contractor plans to work in the following areas this next week: **Weather has caused some delays on the project. We apologize for any inconveniences this has caused.**

### Main Street from Fort Road to 15<sup>th</sup> Street

- The contractor continues work on the west half of Main Street from Fort Road to 15th Street.
- Traffic has been shifted east and will continue to be one lane in each direction.

### 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Frackleton to Main Street

- The contractor has completed utility work and the contractor continues pouring curb and gutter and preparing for paving operations on 16th Street.
- 16th Street is closed to thru traffic from Frackleton to Main Street.

### Demple St from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 15<sup>th</sup> Street

- The contractor has completed utility work and pouring curb and gutter. They continue preparing for paving operations on Demple Street.
- Demple St. will be closed to thru traffic from 16th Street to 15th Street.

### West end of 16<sup>th</sup> Street to Goose Creek

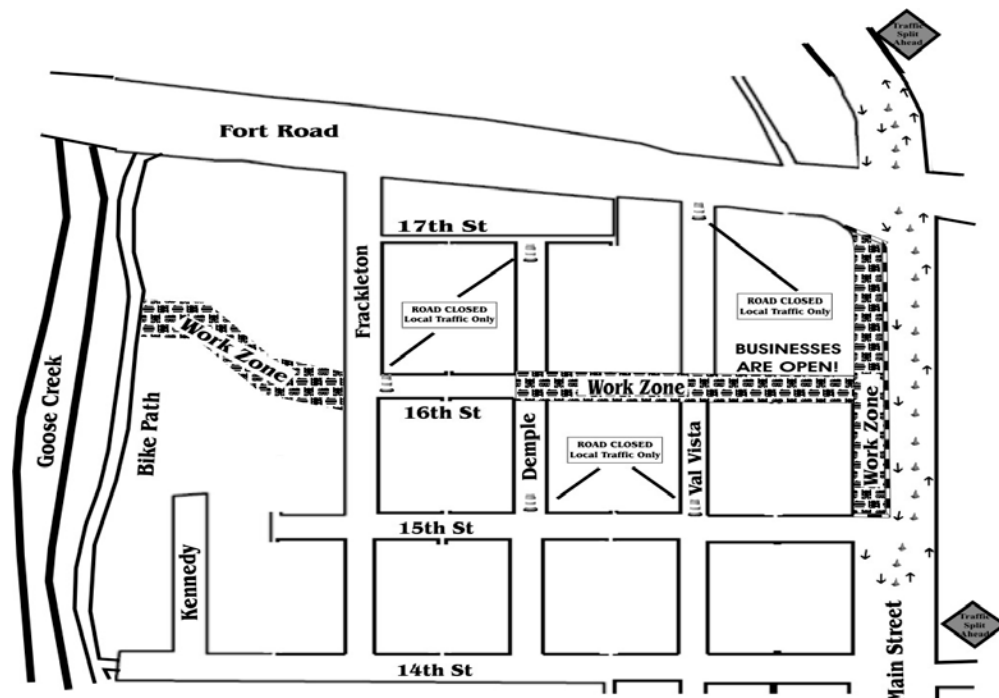
- The contractor continues work on the storm drain outfall from the west end of 16th Street to Goose Creek.

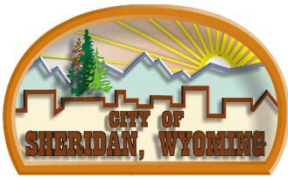
