SUMNER STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Reiman Corp. and Hot Iron, Inc. are planning to begin work on Monday April 3, 2006 (weather permitting). According to their schedule, the first phase of work will be between Coffeen Avenue and up to (but not including) the Heald Street intersection. Work will begin with the removal of the existing roadway, then proceed with installation of new sanitary sewer, water, and finally storm sewer systems. Residents will be notified as work continues beyond this area. The following is a list of items that residents should consider to begin preparing for construction in their area:

1. Vehicles should be removed from the street and driveways as work proceeds between Coffeen and Heald. The existing roadway surface will be removed and will not be accessible for an extended period of time. Alleys will remain accessible and side streets will be available for parking.
2. It is recommended that any landscaping items located within the street right-of-way (decorative rock, bushes, flowers, etc.) be removed/relocated by the resident.
3. It is recommended that residents remove lawn irrigation components located within the street right-of-way. Lawn irrigation systems may need to be adjusted or modified to allow for lawn watering between the sidewalk and the home for the duration of the project.
4. Sheridan Emergency Services (Fire/Ambulance/Police) has indicated that identification of homes from the alley can be difficult in an emergency. If this is a concern to you, please identify your address in a **VISIBLE MANNER** in the alley whenever the street is closed in front of your home.
