

Look at what's new with the City of Sheridan Solid Waste and Recycling Program!

and the City of Sheridan Solid Waste Division
are excited to announce the following:

- The Sheridan Landfill will begin using the new residential drop site located at the landfill starting May 2, 2009. May 2nd is also the first free landfill day of 2009. The residential drop site will allow citizens to dump their garbage onto a concrete slab rather than driving up to the garbage fill area of the landfill. This will help customers on snowing, rainy, and wet days keep from getting muddy and stuck at the landfill. It will also help in litter control and reduce flat tires.
- The K-Mart recycle drop-site located in the K-Mart Parking lot at 2571 North Main is now a full “**One Stop Drop Site**”. Containers are being provided at K-Mart for all commodities currently accepted by the City of Sheridan Recycle Division. This includes: Mixed Paper, Cardboard, Newspaper, Magazines, Aluminum Cans, Tin & Steel Cans, Plastics #1-#7 Screw top Lids only, Glass, and Green Waste.

RECYCLING NOTES:

- The Recycling markets have changed in our area. Our brokers now want magazines, books and newspapers combined. **MIXED PAPER** has changed to **OFFICE PAPER ONLY**. This includes all earth-tone colored paper, sticky notes, envelopes (plastic windows removed) as well as office paper. Do not put in extremely dark colored paper or plastic coated paper.
